HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to
S.P. 113, L.D. 314, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Maine Criminal
Code."

Amend said Amendment on page 15 by striking out all of
the first 2 paragraphs.

Further amend said Amendment on page 15 by striking out
all of the 4th paragraph.

Further amend said Amendment on page 16 by striking out
all but the last 3 paragraphs.

Further amend said Amendment on page 18 by striking out
all of the last 2 paragraphs and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section
51 and all of the Comment and inserting in place thereof the
following:

Sec. 51. 22 MRSA §2383, as last amended by PL 1973,
c. 546, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete from the
provisions of Committee Amendment "B" to the Criminal Code
the section providing for a civil penalty for possession of
any usable amount of marijuana and to also delete the section
providing a presumption of unlawfully furnishing a scheduled
drug if a person possesses more than 1 1/2 ounces of marijuana.
