HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 113, L.D. 314, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Maine Criminal Code."

Amend said Bill in section 51 by striking out all of that part designated "§2383." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 2383. Possession

Possession of a usable amount of marijuana in public is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$200 may be adjudged.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to restrict the civil violation provided by section 51 of the Criminal Code for possession of a usable amount of marijuana to only those instances where such possession occurs in public and to increase the penalty provided from \$100 to \$200.
