HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to S.P. 113, L.D. 314, Bill, "AN
ACT. Creating the Maine Criminal Code."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§1254." in subsection 2 by adding at the end the following:
'A person sentenced to life imprisonment shall not be eligible
for release under the provisions of this section at any time
during said sentence if the victim of the homicide for which
said sentence was imposed was a law enforcement officer, or
was raped by said person in conjunction with said homicide
or was a minor and was sexually abused by said person in
conjunction with said homicide.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that a person
who has been convicted of homicide and sentenced to life
imprisonment, who in committing the homicide for which he is
serving his life sentence, killed a law enforcement officer
or also raped the victim of the homicide or when the victim
and was
was a minor/also sexually abused, ~~and~~ shall not be
eligible at any time during his life sentence for release from
imprisonment.
