HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 113, L.D. 314, Bill,
"AN ACT Creating the Maine Criminal Code."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§1107." in subsection 2 by adding a new paragraph C to
read:

'C. A Class D crime if the drug is marijuana and the
amount does not exceed 1 1/2 ounces and a Class C crime
if the drug is marijuana and the amount exceeds 1 1/2
ounces.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§1107." in the Comment by striking out everything
after the first 2 sentences.

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§1114." in the 2nd and 3rd lines (same in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", the
unauthorized possession of which constitutes a civil violation
under Title 22,"

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§1114." by striking out all of the Comment.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide criminal
penalties for the possession of marijuana.
