**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Marcia S. Webster of Auburn for
Loss by Fire Caused by State Ward.**

Marcia S. Webster; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund, to be paid to Marcia S. Webster, the sum of \$1,735, as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for fire loss caused by a state ward.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On February 11, 1974, a fire occurred in the apartment of Marcia Webster. The fire was caused by a candle which had been lit by Ms. Webster's foster child, Deborah Murphy. Marcia Webster did not have any insurance to cover the damages to her personal belongings. Since Deborah Murphy is a state ward, Marcia Webster should receive reimbursement from the State for the fire damages, and this resolve will provide that reimbursement.
