COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 240, L. D. 318,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Apprentice and  
Journeymen Plumbers and Establishing the Classifi-  
cation of Trainee Plumber."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out  
in the 4th and 9th lines (3rd and 8th lines in  
L.D.) the underlined figure "3" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined figure '2'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by  
striking out all of the 3rd line (same in L. D.)  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§3505-A. Apprentice and trainee plumbers; fees'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by  
striking out in the 8th line (7th line in L. D.)  
the underlined figure "3" and inserting in place  
thereof the underlined figure '2'

Statement of Fact

The original bill increased the required  
training period for apprentice and trainee plumbers  
from one year to 3 years. The purpose of this  
amendment is to reduce this requirement to 2 years.
