**AN ACT to Remove the Restriction Concerning the Tenure of Hairdressing
Members of the Board of Cosmetology.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA, § 1601, 3rd ¶, as amended by PL 1973, c. 137, is further amended to read:

The present hairdressing members of the board shall serve until the expiration of their present term of office and shall be eligible for reappointment ~~however, no person shall be eligible to serve more than 3 consecutive terms.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will remove a restriction on the number of consecutive terms which a hairdressing member of the Board of Cosmetology may serve. Without this restriction, the board members who are working on a national level will be able to continue serving on the board.
