STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Permit Archery Hunting Without a License in Certain Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2502, 2nd ¶ is amended to read:

Section 2401, subsection 1 shall not apply to archery licenses.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act would make Title 12, § 2401, subsection I, apply to archery licenses. Title 12, subsection I reads as follows:

"I. Resident to hunt without license in certain cases. Any resident over IO years of age and members of his immediate family over IO years of age may hunt without a license on any single plot of land in excess of IO acres to which they are legally entitled to possession, and on which they are actually domiciled and which land is used exclusively for agricultural purposes."
