COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.273,L.D.327,
Bill, "AN ACT to Protect Families with Children
and Recipients of Certain Benefits Against
Discrimination in Rental Housing."

Amend said Bill in that part designated
"Sec. 1." by inserting at the end of the first
paragraph after the amending clause the following:
'the provisions not being applicable to owner
occupied dwellings of 4 units or less.'

rental unit.
