HOUSE AMENDMENT" B "to H.P. 273, L.D. 327, Bill,
"AN ACT to Protect Families with Children and
Recipients of Certain Benefits Against Discrimin-
ation in Rental Housing."

Amend said Bill by striking out in section 1
everything after the amending clause and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'For any person to refuse to rent residential
property to families having children, or single
parent families, or to restrict the rental of a
residential unit to a number of related persons
less than can comfortably and safely occupy such
unit solely because of the status of such families
or solely because of the status of such persons as
having children or solely because of being a
single parent family;

For any person furnishing rental premises to
refuse to rent or impose different terms of
tenancy to any individual who is a recipient of
federal, state or local public assistance, in-
cluding medical assistance and housing subsidies
solely because of such individual's status as
such a recipient.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify
the intent of this Act.
