## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 107TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 273, L.D. 327, Bill, "AN ACT to Protect Families with Children and Recipients of Certain Benefits Against Discrimination in Rental Housing."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the words "Families with Children and"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4582, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 705, §8, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

For any person furnishing rental premises to refuse to rent or impose different terms of tenancy to any individual who is a recipient of federal, state or local public assistance, including medical assistance and housing subsidies solely because of such individual's status as such recipient.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 12th, 22nd and 23rd lines (10th and 19th lines in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "family size or composition, or"

## Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from the bill provisions intended to prohibit discrimination in rental housing against families with children but retains provisions which prohibit discrimination in rental housing against persons because they receive public assistance. This amendment also provides that the discrimination in rental housing must be solely on account of the person's receiving public assistance to be prohibited by the bill.
