STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Repealing the Mandatory Incorporation of Regional Planning Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA, § 4512, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 534, § 4, is amended to read:

§ 4512. Incorporation; powers

Regional planning commissions shall may be incorporated in accordance with Title 13, chapter 81, and shall possess all powers of a corporation organized without capital stock, except as limited by this subchapter.

Sec. 2. PL 1973, c. 534, § 5, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to repeal the provisions requiring regional planning commissions to be incorporated, but at the same time allow the commissions to incorporate if they so choose.
