RESOLVE, to Reimburse G. Gordon Gilman of Stow for Loss of Bee Hives by Bear.

G. Gordon Gilman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$165 to be paid to G. Gordon Gilman of Stow as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of 3 bee hives and honey destroyed by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Gilman had 3 of his hives destroyed by a bear on June 1, 1974. Although all bee hive damage claims arising after June 28, 1974 can be handled by the Department of Agriculture under statutory provisions, any damage occurring before June 28 can only be reimbursed by legislative resolve. This resolve will reimburse Mr. Gilman for damage to his hives.
