# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Require Restitution by Offenders whose Cases have been Continued for Sentence and who have been Placed on Probation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA, § 1631, sub-§ 1,  $\P$  A, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 172, § 6, is further amended to read:

**A.** When a person is convicted of an offense which caused damage to another for which civil liability has been established or admitted, the court may continue the case for sentence and place the respondent on probation for a definite time, and may shall order that the respondent make restitution to the person injured.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require restitution by offenders whose cases have been continued for sentence and who have been placed on probation.
