SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 102, L. D. 357, Bill, "AN ACT to Eliminate the 10-day Advance Notice Requirement on License Applications to Sell Liquor at Certain Gatherings."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 lines of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The application may be deemed to be approved by the fact that notification has been made to them.'
