**AN ACT to Provide for Flashing Red Lights on Buses used for
School Purposes by Houses of Religious Worship.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA, § 2011, sub-§ 3 is enacted to read:

3. Private bus. Any motor vehicle owned and used solely for the purpose of school bussing by houses of religious worship or religious societies shall be equipped with and display flashing red lights in accordance with section 2012, subsection 1, paragraph D.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to require buses used by houses of religious worship to transport children to Sunday school to be equipped and to display flashing red lights like other school buses.
