**AN ACT to Change the Name of the Maine Boxing Commission to the
Maine Athletic Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA, § 101, 1st sentence, is amended to read:

The Maine ~~State Boxing~~ Athletic Commission, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of 3 members who shall be appointed for terms of 3 years and may be for cause removed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.

Sec. 2. Amending clause. Wherever in the Revised Statutes the term "Maine Boxing Commission" appears it shall mean the "Maine Athletic Commission."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation would enable the commission to have a more realistic name in order to add other professional sports to their regulatory duties as is done in other states.
