STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to State Employees Serving in Acting Capacities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA, § 677 is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

No employee shall serve in an acting capacity in any position in the classified service of the State unless that employee is certified eligible for the position by the director. Any employee serving in an acting capacity in excess of 30 calendar days shall be paid the salary assigned to the position utilizing the same merit or longevity step the employee has reached in his regular position.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify eligibility and compensation requirements as they relate to an employee who occupies a position in an acting capacity.
