COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 318, L. D. 387, RESOLVE, Authorizing Sherman Collins, Francis Fitzmaurice, the Estate of Durward G. Turner, Durward G. Turner, Jr., David G. Turner and Ellen S. Turner to Bring Civil Action Against the State of Maine.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 54th line (50th and 51st in L. D.) before the Emergency clause the words "Chesterville Road" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Knowlton Corner Road'; and by inserting after the word "assistants" in the 13th line (12th line in L.D.) the words 'or designee'; and by striking out in the 8th and 9th lines (8th line in L.D.) the words "State Treasury" and inserting in place thereof the words 'General Highway Fund'; and by striking out in the 4th line (same in L.D.) the figure "\$505,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$250,000'; and by striking out in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) the words "with jury" and inserting in place thereof the words 'with or without jury'

Fiscal Note

In the event that a judgment is recovered against the State of Maine in the civil action authorized by this resolve, the maximum amount which may be paid out of the General Highway Fund in payment of such a judgment is \$250,000.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct, clarify and to reduce the maximum amount of recovery to \$250,000 which shall be paid out of the General Highway Fund.
