COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 316, L.D. 394, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Allow Certain Nonprofit, Volunteer and Educational  
Organizations to Operate Games of Chance without a License from  
the Maine State Police."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §332, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 735,  
§3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any license now issued by the Maine State Police may  
also be issued by the town clerk of the municipality in  
which the raffle is to be held. If the final report indicates  
that the gross receipts were less than \$1,000, then the  
license fee shall be refunded.

Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §338, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 735,  
§3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The printer shall print the permit number on every raffle  
ticket to be sold.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the present material of the bill and  
inserts in its place a provision permitting town clerks to  
issue raffle licenses, a provision for the refund of the permit  
fee in certain situations and a provision requiring the printing  
of the permit number on every ticket for a licensed raffle.
