HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 316, L.D. 394, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Certain Nonprofit, Volunteer and Educational Organizations to Operate Games of Chance without a License from the Maine State Police."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §332, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 735, §3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

An organization licensed to conduct a raffle shall not be required to pay a license fee; provided, however, that if the raffle conducted by an organization results in gross receipts of \$1,000 or more, the organization shall be required to pay a license fee of \$10 within 2 weeks of the date of the drawing.

Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §338, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 735, §3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The printer shall print the permit number on every raffle ticket to be sold.

Sec. 3. 17 MRSA §339, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 735, §3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

This section shall not apply to applications which are only for raffle licenses.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the present material of the bill and inserts in its place a provision establishing a free license for raffles grossing under \$1,000 and a provision requiring the printing of the permit number on every ticket for a licensed raffle.
