HOUSE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 326, L.D. 398, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fines and Penalties under Fire Prevention Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2440, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 622, §84, is amended to read:

§2440. Penalties; recovery and appropriation

Penalties provided in sections 2431 to 2436 and section 2439 may be recovered by complaint, indictment or civil action, 1/2 to the town where the offense is committed and 1/2 to the prosecutor State.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to continue to provide funds to the municipalities for fire prevention.
