

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 333, L.D. 405, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Hearing for Provisional Motor Vehicle Licensee on Suspension."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "on Suspension"

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'29 MRSA §2241, last ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 361, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The original license issued to a new applicant shall be a provisional license for a period of one year following the date of issue and shall remain in force as a nonprovisional license to the 2nd birthdate following the date of issue. If a person is convicted of a motor vehicle moving violation while in the possession of a provisional license such person shall be subject to the same penalty as a nonprovisional licensee.

## Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide provisional licensees with an opportunity to be heard in the same manner as nonprovisional licensees.
