STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement of Employees in Direct Contact with Patients at State Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA, § 1121, sub-§ 3, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 542, § 8, is further amended by adding at the end 2 new sentences to read:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, all employees in direct contact with patients at state hospitals, within the Department of Mental Health and Corrections, who attain 20 years of creditable service may be retired forthwith on a service retirement allowance which shall be equal to $\frac{2}{3}$ of their final average compensation. These employees shall contribute at the rate of $7\frac{1}{2}\%$ of earnable compensation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill relates to service retirement of employees in direct contact with patients at state hospitals.
