RESOLVED, to Reimburse Jack and Peter Rich of Rich Brothers Farm, Cape Elizabeth, for Crop Damage by Deer.

Jack and Peter Rich of Rich Brothers Farm; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$900 to be paid to Jack and Peter Rich of Rich Brothers Farm, Cape Elizabeth, as a full and final settlement of their claim against the State for crop damage by deer.

This resolve is to reimburse Jack and Peter Rich of Rich Brothers Farm, Cape Elizabeth, as a full and final payment for \$900 worth of damage to their squash crop by deer from the Sprague Game Preserve in Cape Elizabeth.
