STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Additional Construction Costs of International Arrivals Building at Bangor International Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$310,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 to be expended under the direction of the Department of Transportation for the construction of an International Arrivals Building and Related Facilities at Bangor International Airport. This appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this appropriation is to provide funding for additional costs of construction of the international arrivals building and related facilities at Bangor International Airport.
