IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse A. L. Stewart and Sons of Cherryfield for Loss of Beehives by Bear.

A. L. Stewart and Sons; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,889 to be paid to A. L. Stewart and Sons of Cherryfield as a full and final settlement of its claim against the State for loss of beehives and bee colonies destroyed by bear during April, 1973.

STATEMENT OF FACT

During April, 1973, beehives leased by A. L. Stewart and Sons were damaged by bear. Under the terms of its lease, Stewart and Sons was required to reimburse the owners of the beehives for the damage.

As the damage took place prior to June 28, 1974, there is no statutory provision for reimbursement of this damage. This resolve will reimburse A. L. Stewart and Sons \$1,889 for damage to its leased beehives.
