## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Unlawful Discrimination in the Extension of Credit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA, § 4595, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 668, is amended to read:

The opportunity for every individual to be extended credit without discrimination solely because of age, race, color, sex, marital status, ancestry, religious creed or national origin is recognized as and declared to be a civil right.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the illogical possibility that a person would be allowed to discriminate on account of any 2 or more of the above criteria while being prohibited from discriminating on account of only one of the above factors.
