STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Clarify the Use of Initial Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA, § 192, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 469, § 1, is further amended to read:

The Secretary of State is authorized to design and to issue, under such regulations as he shall deem appropriate, initial type registration plates or combination of initials and numeric type registration plates to be used on passenger motor vehicles, **excluding buses**, or motor vehicles of the station wagon type or motorcycles or camper vehicles in lieu of other numeric type registration plates.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA, § 192, 3rd ¶, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 469, § 2, is further amended to read:

Applications for registration plates as prescribed above, pertaining to owners of passenger vehicles, excluding buses, or motor vehicles of the station wagon type or motorcycles or camper vehicles who are residents of this State and who own an unrevoked and unexpired official amateur radio station license issued by the Federal Communications Commission, except those licensed as novices by the Federal Communications Commission, shall be accompanied by a notarized proof of ownership of such amateur radio station license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will clarify the types of vehicles authorized to display initial, or so-called, vanity, plates.
