## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Transporting Deer in Open View.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2355, sub-§ 2, ¶ A, as last amended by PL 1965, c. 448, § 14, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

After a deer has been legally registered at a deer registration station, it shall not be necessary to transport said deer open to view.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to help the problem of having to transport a deer open to view for long distances.
