## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

### AN ACT Relating to Hunting Pheasants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2401, sub-§ 7, is enacted to read:

7. Pheasant stamp. It shall be unlawful for any person who has attained the age of 16 years to hunt or have in possession any pheasant unless at the time of such hunting or possession he has on his person an unexpired State of Maine pheasant stamp validated by his signature written across the face of the stamp in ink. Such stamp shall be issued by the commissioner or his authorized agent at a fee of \$3.50, 50¢ of which shall be retained by the issuing agent. Such stamp shall be exhibited to any warden or employee of the department upon request.

### FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that there will be an increase in revenue to the State of \$18,000.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will continue the pheasant stamp requirement that was in effect for the years 1973 and 1974.
