**AN ACT to Repeal the Seasonality Provisions of the Employment Security Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** 26 MRSA, § 1192, sub-§ 5, first sentence, as amended, is further amended to read:

**For each eligible individual establishing a benefit year on and after September 30, 1975, if he has been paid during his base period wages of at least \$600 \$200 for insured work in each of 2 different quarters in his base period and has been paid total wages of at least \$600 in his base period for insured work.**

**Sec. 2.** 26 MRSA, § 1251, as amended by PL 1973, c. 516, is repealed.

**Sec. 3. Effective date.** This Act shall become effective September 30, 1975.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the seasonality provisions of the Employment Security Law and amends the Employment Security Law to require unemployment insurance claimants to demonstrate attachment to the labor market.
