## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATIVE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 133, L. D. 438, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Funds to Pine Tree Legal Assistance, Inc., for Continued Legal Representation for those in Need."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the first paragraph, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'No money from this appropriation shall be used, directly or indirectly, to pay any expenses in connection with a civil suit against the State, any county in the State, any municipality or any plantation in the State. However, this paragraph shall not be construed to prohibit or limit the expenditure of federally derived moneys for any purpose permitted for those moneys under the Constitution or statutes of the United States or duly promulgated rules and regulations of the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment will prohibit use of state moneys appropriated to Pine Tree Legal Assistance, Inc., under this bill for payment of any expenses involved in a suit against the State, a county, a municipality or a plantation.
