STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain County Officials of Oxford
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA, § 2, 10th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Oxford County: County commissioners, \$2,600; chairman, \$2,800; clerk of courts, \$7,500; county treasurer, \$3,600; sheriff, \$11,000; register of deeds, eastern district, \$8,000; register of deeds, western district, \$5,000; judge of probate, \$5,200; register of probate, \$6,200;

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1975.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act increases the salaries of certain county officials of Oxford County in order to reflect the large increase in the cost of living caused by inflation.
