#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize the Governor's Committee on Children and Youth to Accept and Administer Certain Available Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P & SL 1973, c. 129, Pt. A, § 4-A, is enacted to read:

Sec. 4-A. Federal programs and funds. The committee shall be the designated state agency to handle all programs of the Federal Government relating to children and youth requiring actions within the State which are not the specific responsibility of another state agency under the provisions of federal or state law. Authority is conferred on the committee to accept, use and administer any funds, including federal, state and private funds, in accordance with established budgetary procedures, which might become available pursuant to the purposes set out in this Part. The committee may receive on its own behalf or on behalf of the State any grants or gifts and may accept them.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will enable the Governor's Committee on Children and Youth to accept federal funds, grants and gifts and to administer these funds in a fashion similar to the Governor's Committee on Aging.
