STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Alton M. Dixon of Orrington for Property Damage Caused by Beaver.

Alton M. Dixon; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$509 to be paid to Alton M. Dixon of Orrington as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his camp road caused by beaver.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Dixon owns a camp road on Chemo Pond, which crosses Sibley Brook in Clifton. From time to time, beavers have dammed up the culvert under the private road, which has led to the brook overflowing and consequently washing out Mr. Dixon's road. Mr. Dixon has repeatedly contacted the Inland Fisheries and Game Department, but its best efforts have not led to the elimination of the beaver problem.

Mr. Dixon has suffered approximately \$509 worth of damage in rebuilding his culverts and in laying new gravel to repair the beaver damage since 1971. This resolve will reimburse Mr. Dixon for that damage.
