STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse David P. Mayo of Deer Isle for Fine Erroneously Paid to the State.

David P. Mayo; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$200 to be paid to David P. Mayo of Deer Isle as reimbursement of a fine erroneously paid to the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse David P. Mayo of Deer Isle a \$200 fine which was originally intended as restitution to Mr. Mayo for the malicious killing of his cow but was erroneously remitted to the State.

On May 14, 1974, a cow, valued at \$600, belonging to David P. Mayo of Deer Isle was shot and killed. Three individuals were charged and convicted of violating Title 17, section 1092, maliciously killing livestock. A fine of \$300 was imposed on each individual; \$200 of which was suspended provided that the 3 convicted make restitution of the same to Mr. Mayo for his loss. Through a breakdown in communications, one of the convicted individuals failed to make payment by the required date August 27, 1974. A capias order was issued by the court which in turn remitted the same to the State instead of to Mr. Mayo.
