COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 383, L.D. 476, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Market and Public Opinion Research Services under the Unemployment Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined blocked paragraph after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'(30) Services performed by a contract interviewer engaged in marketing research or public opinion interviewing, when such interviewing is conducted in the field or over the telephone on premises not used or controlled by the person for whom such contract services are being provided.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the activities of a contract interviewer.
