STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide a Bounty on Coyote under the Inland Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2901, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1967, c. 198, is further amended to read:

There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobcat and coyote which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is to eliminate the threat of coyote in the western portion of the State.
