HOUSE AMENDMENT" A "to H.P. 399, L.D. 488, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for the Election of Each County  
Commissioner of York County by only the Electors of  
the District Represented."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line after the enacting clause, the follow-  
ing: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the  
end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition. The present incumbents  
shall continue in office for the remainder of the  
term in which they currently serve. Thereafter,  
elections shall continue in a manner so that each  
district shall have on the board of commissioners a  
resident of that district elected by the voters of  
that district.'
