**AN ACT Relating to the Use of Leg Hold Traps
under the Inland Fish and Game Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2403 is enacted to read:

§ 2403. Trap restrictions

It shall be unlawful for any person to use auxiliary teeth on any leg hold trap set on land.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to assure the use of more humane equipment in trapping game.
