COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " a " to H.P. 401, L.D. 490, Bill,
"AN Act Relating to Certain Overtime Exemptions under Minimum
Wage Law."

Amend said Bill in the 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th
lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the following: "except
that on October 15, 1975 to January 1, 1976, those employees
in hotels, motels, restaurants and other eating establishments
shall be paid 1 1/2 times their regular hourly rate for all
work done over 46 hours in one week, on January 1, 1976 to
January 1, 1977, for all work done over 44 hours in one week,
and thereafter for all work done over 40 hours" and inserting
in place thereof the following: '; except that beginning
October 15, 1975 those employees in hotels, motels, restaurants
and other eating establishments shall be paid 1 1/2 times
their regular hourly rate for all work done over 46 hours;
except that maids and custodial workers employed in hotels,
motels, restaurants and other eating establishments shall be
paid 1 1/2 times their regular hourly rate for all work done
over 46 hours beginning October 15, 1975, 1 1/2 times their
regular hourly rate for all work done over 44 hours beginning
May 1, 1976, and 1 1/2 times their regular hourly rate for
all work done over 40 hours beginning May 1, 1977;'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish for employees
of hotels, motels, restaurants and other eating establishments
an overtime payment rate like the rate for similar employees
covered by federal legislation.
