HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 403, L.D. 492,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Equalize the Retail Price of  
Alcoholic Beverages Throughout the State."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning  
of the first line after the enacting clause the  
underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the  
end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §451, first ¶, as last amended  
by PL 1971, c. 268, §2, is further amended by adding  
at the end 2 new sentences to read:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section,  
the commission shall establish and maintain uniform  
prices for sales of liquor in all state retail  
liquor stores throughout the State. The uniform  
retail price shall be equal to the lowest price  
allowed in any state retail liquor store.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to lower the  
prices at all retail stores to the Kittery store  
prices.
