AN ACT to Promote the Professional Standards of the Unclassified Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA, § 712, is enacted to read:

§ 712. State Personnel Board review

The State Personnel Board shall review the wages, hours and working conditions of the unclassified service, in order to prevent possible inequities and arbitrariness in these areas and to insure compliance with federal personnel standards. The Personnel Board shall report yearly to a regular or special session of the Legislature the results of its review, with, if necessary, recommendations for changes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to guard against possible inequities and arbitrariness in the wages, hours and working conditions of the unclassified service and to insure compliance with federal personnel standards.
