HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 411, L.D. 499,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Use of Colored Lights
on Certain Fire and Emergency Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in the last line before the
Statement of Fact (next to last line in L.D.) by
inserting after the underlined word "constables"
the underlined words 'in uniform'

of light on their vehicle.
