SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 411, L. D. 499, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Use of Colored Lights on Certain Fire and Emergency Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following underlined sentence:

'At no time shall any constable operate such light unless he is in uniform.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that constables be in uniform to emit a blue beam of light on their vehicles.
