STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Require the Identification in Telephone Company Directories of Subscribers using Recording Answering Devices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA, § 257 is enacted to read:

§ 257. Telephone company directories

Any telephone company which causes a telephone directory to be prepared for distribution to telephone company subscribers shall clearly identify therein, by mark or otherwise, those telephone numbers which represent telephones known or which should have been known by reasonable inquiry to have recording answering devices attached thereto at the time the directory is finally prepared for printing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require telephone company directories to be printed in a fashion that would afford the toll calling public advance information that a station to station toll call may be answered by a recording answering device.
