SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 419, L. D. 505, Bill, "AN ACT Placing the Secretary to the Attorney General in Unclassified Service of State Government."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'


Further amend said Bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §196, last sentence, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 711, §4, is amended to read:

The compensations of the deputy attorneys general, staff attorneys and, assistant attorneys general and secretary to the Attorney General shall be fixed by the Attorney General with the approval of the Governor and Council, but such compensations shall not in the aggregate exceed the amount appropriated therefor.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the compensation for the secretary of the Attorney General shall be fixed by the Attorney General with the approval of the Governor and Executive Council.
