CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 147, L.D. 510, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Number of Associate Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial Court the sum of \$49,662 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'<u>Sec. 3. Effective date.</u> This Act shall become effective July 1, 1976.'
