HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 147, L.D. 510,
Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Number of Associate
Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the
emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all
of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is
appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme
Judicial Court the sum of \$86,909 to carry out
the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be
as follows:

Further amend said Bill by striking out all
of the emergency clause.
